

**Instructions on certification and licensing**

**The 11-13 weeks scan:** To obtain a certificate of competence you need to attend the online course on the 11-13 weeks scan and submit images for nuchal translucency. This will give you a license which enables access to the software for calculation of risk for trisomies based on nuchal translucency with or without biochemistry. For access to calculation of risk based on **nasal bone, ductus venosus** and **tricuspid flow** you need to upload images for these ultrasound markers as well. To maintain your licenses you need to submit images for each marker every year. To submit images please [click here](#).

**Preeclampsia screening:** To obtain a certificate of competence and license you need to attend the online course on preeclampsia screening and submit images. To maintain your license you need to submit images every year. To submit images please [click here](#).

**Fetal abnormalities:** To obtain a certificate of competence it is advisable that you attend the online course on fetal abnormalities and you need to pass a practical examination and submit images. There is no need for licensing. For instructions on preparing and submitting a logbook of images please [click here](#).

**Fetal echocardiography:** To obtain a certificate of competence you need to attend the online course on fetal cardiac scanning and pass a practical examination. This certificate is applicable only to FMF fellows. There is no need for licensing.

**Doppler ultrasound:** To obtain a certificate of competence you need to attend the online course on Doppler ultrasound and submit images. There is no need for licensing. To submit images please [click here](#).

**Cervical screening:** To obtain a certificate of competence you need to attend the online course on cervical assessment and submit images. There is no need for licensing. To submit images please [click here](#).
